**RE: ESSENTIAL TRAIL MAINTENANCE
DEUA AND MONGA NPs**

NPWS staff and contractors will commence essential road/trail maintenance work in the coming weeks at the following locations:

Gollaribee Mountain Rd
Quart Pot Fire Trail
Gollaribee Fire Trail
Minuma Range Fire Trail
Boundary Fire Trail

Once work starts it is expected to take up to 3 to 4 weeks to complete (depending on weather conditions). We do not expect the need to close any of these roads while works are underway but it is advisable if you are planning a trip to Deua or Monga NPs to contact the local NPWS office for advice on access to these areas while works are underway. Information will also be posted on the website at www.nationalparks.nsw.gov.au

We also ask that visitors follow any signage advice that may be displayed on these roads and trails while works are carried out and to drive with caution and to the current conditions.
