RE: Access to Deua, Monga, Gourock, Tallaganda and Eurobodalla NPs

As a result of recent severe weather there has been a significant amount of tree fall throughout the parks impacting some trails. Some roads and trails have been cleared but there are still several yet to be assessed.

Bendethera Camping Area has been re-opened. The river crossings have changed due to flooding and have deepened in sections. Visitors are advised to use caution if crossing.

Access to the Corn Trail carpark via Misty Mountain Rd and No Name Mountain Rd remains <u>**CLOSED</u>** due to flood damage. Penance Grove Walking Trail is <u>**CLOSED**</u> due to storm damage.</u>

Storms have also caused significant damage to beaches. There may be temporary closures whilst works are completed. Closures will be signposted onsite; please follow instructions on any signs you see.
