RE: ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE – LITTLE SUGARLOAF ROAD DEUA NP

Contractors will commence essential road maintenance work on Little Sugarloaf Road starting **Monday 25**th **July 2016**.

During this time sections of Little Sugarloaf Road will be <u>CLOSED</u> to all traffic. Works are expected to take between 3 - 4 weeks to complete (depending on weather conditions).

As the road will be closed to all traffic, there will be no access to Bendethera Camping Area for vehicles towing trailers. Four wheel drive vehicles without trailers can still access Bendethera from the west via Middle Mountain Road, Minuma Range and Dampier Mountain Fire Trails or from Araluen Road via Dry Creek, Merricumbene and Bendethera Fire Trails.

Other trails that will be closed while roadworks are underway include Coondella Fire Trail (south of Wamban Fire Trail intersection). Penalties apply for non-compliance.

If you are planning a trip to Deua NP (in particular Bendethera) it is advisable that you contact the local NPWS office for advice on access while works are underway. This information will also be posted on the website at www.nationalparks.nsw.gov.au
