**RE: ACCESS ON CLARKS ROAD 4WD ONLY -  
BIAMANGA NATIONAL PARK**

Due recent days of storms and heavy rainfall the area we are advising the public that the **Clarks Road** leading into Biamanga National Park (including to Mumbulla Creek Falls) is passable to **4WD vehicles only** until further notice.

The trail surface is rutted in places wet and slippery making it **impassable for 2WD vehicles.** There may also be fallen trees or timber down across the roads and trails.

Visitors and locals to the area are advised to delay their visit to Biamanga National Park until weather conditions improve and roads and trails can be inspected.

As weather conditions improve alternate access to Mumbulla Creek Falls for 2WD vehicles will be available from the east via Dr George Mountain Road and Mumbulla Creek Road.

Weather permitting road works to rectify the damage to Clarks Road are proposed to occur as soon as possible and local closures to the road will occur intermittently during works.
